The course covers key topics and issues including:

- Managing common situations—speed, right-of-way, driving left of center, proper following distance, lane changes and lane markings, safe passing and overtaking
- Handling challenging situations—head-on crashes, work zones, turns and intersection collisions, and scanning and backing techniques
- ▶ Inspecting your equipment—pre-trip, en-route and post-trip inspections
- ► Physical and mental conditions—stress management, drowsy driving and sleep patterns, anger, anxiety, vision, hearing, mobility and medications
